ANSWER: No

- "Exodus 26:33 — divide unto you between the holy place and the holiest of all.
- Exodus 26:34 — put the mercy seat above upon the ark of the testimony in the holy of holies.
- Leviticus 16:2 — he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail.
- Leviticus 16:16 — atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleannesses.
- Leviticus 16:17 — no man in the tabernacle when he goeth in to the holy place.
- Leviticus 16:20 — end of atoning for the holy place, and the tabernacle.
- Leviticus 16:23 — put off the linen garments when he went into the holy place.
