

An Open Letter to All Christians and Church Leaders

Re: Supernatural Bible Changes

For the last eight years, Christians in the Mandela Effect community have been attempting to open dialogues with church leaders regarding the fact that the Scriptures are being supernaturally manipulated by the devil, with God's permission.

The response from virtually all church leaders has been to throw up an embargo of silence and denial—a response that is nothing short of criminal. But that is all about to end.

God's decision to remove His Word as a judgment has taken place several times throughout the Bible, clearly establishing His willingness to do this again in modernity. Do not think for a moment that God would never allow this.

The evidence for this event is so overwhelming that the inability of church leadership to recognize it has become more of a phenomenon than the phenomenon itself.

It is an undeniable fact that most pastors, virtually without exception anywhere in the world, will misremember a long and ever-growing list of very familiar passages in exactly the same way (see Bible Quiz). If this phenomenon were caused by simple, everyday misremembering, then we would not all be misremembering the same way.

The chances of only five people misremembering five simple Bible quiz questions the same way by chance is approximately 10^{25} .

So, what are the chances of virtually the entire human race misremembering 15 to 20 Scriptures in exactly the same way by chance? The answer is: it's not possible. We're not just misremembering; we're all misremembering the same way, and there has to be a cause for that.

If church leaders want to continue to appear rational, they are going to have to provide a public statement regarding what they believe the cause to be for this observation. If they insist on ignoring this repeatable empirical evidence but persist in claiming that there is no evidence to support a supernatural Bible-change phenomenon, then they will be held accountable.

Unless the church can answer that question, they will be forced to consider that there must be a more nuanced understanding of the doctrine of preservation.

The evidence found in these educational documents and my free book will begin to answer many of the questions that may arise regarding how this could be happening without impugning God's character in any way.

As our material will attempt to show, God never promised to preserve the Scriptures. He promised to preserve His Word, and they are not the same. The Bible doesn't promise, "Thy Scriptures, O Lord, are forever settled in heaven."

Additionally, it has probably never dawned on most Christians to ask where He promised to save His Word. When you actually look closely at what the text is teaching, you will find that He only promised to preserve it in our hearts, not on the pages of your KJV Bible in English. 2nd Corinthians 3:3 seems to even provide a specific prohibition against preserving it on any earthly medium, i.e., "not on tablets of stone and not with ink."

So, what is the evidence that all Bibles are supernaturally changing? There is the testimony of millions of consecrated, biblically literate Christians claiming emphatically that their Bible is supernaturally changing.

There is the scientific discipline of probabilities, which removes every objection to those testimonies, because everyone in the world is misremembering 15 to 20 Scriptures the exact same way, which is statistically impossible without a cause.

We have peer-reviewed studies from the scientific community confirming that there is an unexplainable phenomenon taking place. We have expert testimony from people like Dr. Paul Grafton Holt and from large software companies like Entree, which had to notify their entire customer base because supernatural changes in product names were causing massive inventory problems for their software and customers.

You have biblical prophecy foretelling the event with stunning accuracy.

We've now identified over 20 different types of changes within the Bible, highlighting that our conclusion is not based on memory alone. The entire Mandela Effect community has watched four things in pop culture change and then change back again. We call this a flip-flop, and it is impossible for naysayers to deny or explain.

Neither does the unconvinced have a rational explanation for the mountain of residual evidence supporting our vivid memories. There is no precedent in recorded history for an event like this, which supports its status as a phenomenon. And if it is a phenomenon, then it cannot be caused by everyday misremembering.

All attempts to explain our testimonies by suggesting that we're all just confused by misquotes from pop culture, variants, modernizations, or misprints are swept aside by the fact that the church has no explanation for how all of humanity is misremembering the exact same way. It is not a government psyop, and it is not caused by confabulation, implanted thoughts, or demonic deception.

It is an Amos 8:11-type judgment from God because His shepherds are overemphasizing the Bible in the life of the believer. It is caused by the devil, with God's permission, to fulfill end-times prophecy and reveal the fact that many Christians are as blinded by doctrines as the Pharisees were when they chose their Sabbath rule over allowing Jesus to heal the man with the withered hand.

Many have embraced an intellectual, miracle-free gospel that has turned the Bible into an idol. And so, judgment has begun with the house of God because many are searching the Scriptures for what they think is eternal life, but they have left off walking with the Author. As a result, God has sent this Tower of Babel judgment to ask His church this question:

“Do you know Me, or do you just know the book?”
