The Ten Commandments most famously appear in:

- Exodus 20:1–17
- Deuteronomy 5:6–21

However, Exodus 34:11–28 is often called a "renewed covenant", and verse 28 even says: "he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments." But the content of Exodus 34 is significantly different from the traditional Ten Commandments in Exodus 20. Only 3 to 4 of the traditional Ten Commandments (no other gods, no idols, Sabbath, possibly coveting) appear in Exodus 34. The rest are replaced with ceremonial and covenantal laws unique to Israel.
