“Universal Theological Paradoxes”

Eating flesh — 2 Kings 6:28–29 “This woman said unto me, Give thy son, that we may eat him to day, and we will eat my son to morrow.” “So we boiled my son, and did eat him: and I said unto her on the next day, Give thy son, that we may eat him: and she hath hid her son.”

Ezekiel 5:10 “Therefore fathers will eat their sons in your midst, and sons will eat their fathers. I will inflict punishment on you and will scatter all your survivors to the winds.”

Micah 3:2-3 “You rulers hate good and love evil; you tear the skin from my people and the flesh from their bones. You eat the flesh of my people, strip off their skin, break their bones and chop them up like meat in a pot, like flesh in a cauldron.”

Isaiah and “a prophetess” — Isaiah 8:3 “And I went unto the prophetess; and she conceived, and bare a son. Then said the LORD to me, Call his name Mahershalalhashbaz.”

Slay those who won’t have Him reign — Luke 19:27 “But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay them before me.”

Happy smashing babies — Psalm 137:9 (KJV)

“Happy shall he be, that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones.”

Spit-healing — Mark 8:23 (KJV)

“And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.”

Sacrificing female sheep — Leviticus 4:32 (KJV)

“And if he bring a lamb for a sin offering, he shall bring it a female without blemish.”

“I robbed other churches” — 2 Corinthians 11:8 (KJV)

“I robbed other churches, taking wages of them, to do you service.”

Eat dung / drink piss — 2 Kings 18:27 (KJV)

“But Rabshakeh said unto them, Hath my master sent me to thy master and to thee to speak these words? hath he not sent me to the men which sit on the wall, that they may eat their own dung, and drink their own piss with you?”

Theological paradoxes - KJV-only

Sacrificing turtles forbidden — Leviticus 11:29–30 (KJV); Leviticus 1:3–4 (KJV)

- **Leviticus 11:29–30** “These also shall be unclean unto you among the creeping things that creep upon the earth; the weasel, and the mouse, and the **tortoise** after his kind,”
“And the ferret, and the chameleon, and the lizard, and the snail, and the mole.”
- **Leviticus 1:3–4** “If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, **let him offer a male without blemish**: he shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD.”
“And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.”

Sacrificing Turtles — Leviticus 12:8 (KJV) “**And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles**, or two young pigeons; the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.”

Singing turtles — Song of Solomon 2:12 (KJV) “The flowers appear on the earth; the time of the singing of birds is come, and the voice of the **turtle** is heard in our land;”

Turtles flying south for the winter — Jeremiah 8:7 (KJV) “Yea, the stork in the heaven knoweth her appointed times; and the **turtle** and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the LORD.”

Nursing fathers — Isaiah 49:23 (KJV) “**And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers:** they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.”

Sucking the breasts of kings — Isaiah 60:16 (KJV) “**Thou shalt also suck the milk of the Gentiles, and shalt suck the breast of kings:** and thou shalt know that I the LORD am thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.”

Men with breast milk — “His breasts are full of milk” — Job 21:24 (KJV) “**His breasts are full of milk,** and his bones are moistened with marrow.”

Two men in a bed / One gets raptured — Luke 17:34–35 (KJV) “I tell you, in that night there shall be **two men in one bed;** the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left.”

“**Two women shall be grinding** together; the one shall be taken, and the other left.”

Revelation 1:13 (KJV) “Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about with the **'paps' with a golden girdle.** Paps = mas-tos; from the base of G3145; properly, female breast. **Did not use stethos - male breast**

A bishop must be a “lover of good men” — Titus 1:8 (KJV) “But a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate;”

There is no God — Isaiah 45:14 (KJV) “they shall come after thee; in chains they shall come over, and they shall fall down unto thee, they shall make supplication unto thee, saying, Surely God is in thee; and there is none else, **there is no God.**”

Leaving the principles of Christ — Hebrews 6:1 (KJV) “Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,”

Ephesians 6:12 (Compare to Titus 3:1) For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. **(This is correct)**

- **Titus 3:1** Put them in mind **to be subject to principalities and powers**, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, **(Should be rulers)**
- **John 21:7** "Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt his fisher's coat unto him, **(for he was naked,)** and did cast himself into the sea."
- **Mark 14:51–52** And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast **about his naked body**; and the young men laid hold on him:
And he left the linen cloth, and fled from them naked.

Warning against cross dressing

- Deuteronomy 22:5 "The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination unto the LORD thy God."

Girdles & Bonnets

- Exodus 28:40 "And for Aaron's sons thou shalt make coats, and thou shalt make for them **girdles, and bonnets** shalt thou make for them, for glory and for beauty."
- Revelation 15:6 "And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with **golden girdles.**"

Lace

- Exodus 28:37 "And thou shalt put it on a **blue lace**, that it may be upon the mitre; upon the forefront of the mitre it shall be."

Aprons

- Genesis 3:7 "And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves **aprons.**"

Linen breeches

- Exodus 28:42 "And thou shalt make them **linen breeches** to cover their nakedness; from the loins even unto the thighs they shall reach."

Deuteronomy 27:20

Acts 22:25

We should respect people with gay clothing — James 2:3 (KJV)
